Like No Place Else On Earth

Crater Lake has inspired people for thousands of years. No place else on earth combines a deep, pure lake, so blue in color; sheer surrounding cliffs, almost two thousand feet high, two picturesque islands; and a violent volcanic past. It is a place of immeasurable beauty.



Day 1 - Sunday, August 19

Depart from the Target parking lot in Davis at 7:30 am and begin your tour of wonderment and inspiration. Visit Lassen Volcanic National Park, often called California's Yellowstone for its many geological and hydrothermal features, expansive meadows and pristine lakes and streams. See bubbling mud, hissing fumaroles, boiling lakes and unimaginably beautiful colors. Visit the Kohm Yah-mah-nee Visitor Center which get its name from the Mountain Maidu word for Lassen Peak, which means "Snow Mountain". Check into the Shilo Inn in Klamath Falls late afternoon. Enjoy the Roadhouse Buffet Dinner this evening at the hotel. (D)

Day 2 - Monday, August 20

Depart from the hotel this morning and travel to the awe inspiring, Crater Lake. Native Americans witnessed its formation 7,700 years ago when a violent eruption triggered the collapse of a tall peak. Scientists marvel at its purity; fed by rain and snow, it is the deepest lake in the United States and perhaps the most pristine on earth. Gaze in wonder at its blue water and stunning setting atop the Cascade Mountain Range. Stop at the Visitor Center and watch a short video describing of history of the lake. Friendly and informative park rangers will be available to answer any questions you may have. Your accommodations for this evening will be the Springhill Suites in Medford. Evening at leisure. (B)

Day 3 - Tuesday, August 21

Depart the hotel after breakfast this morning and see the majestic Oregon Dunes, the largest expanse of coastal sand dunes in North America. From Florence to Coos Bay, the Oregon Dunes extend 40 miles along the coast. Formed by ancient forces of wind, water, and time, these dunes are like no other in the world. Accommodations this evening are at the Mill Casino Hotel, overlooking the beautiful waters of Coos Bay. The hotel has five unique dining venues to choose from this evening. (B)

Day 4 - Wednesday, August 22

Depart Oregon this morning and travel south seeing breathtaking ocean views and quaint seaside towns. Stop in Orrick and see the Redwood National Visitor Center, located on a beautiful beach. Humboldt Redwoods State Park is California's 3rd largest park with 53,000 acres and the largest old growth contiguous redwood forest in the world! Continue on to Eureka and check into the Red Lion Hotel. A fabulous dinner at the hotel is planned for this evening. (B,D)

Day 5 - Thursday, August 23

Board the coach this morning for the silence and grandeur of the Avenue of the Giants. Take the short walk to Founder's Grove, a truly exceptional site. The Grove is notable for its sheer size as the redwoods extend as far as you can see in every direction. No other lowland grove feels quite so expansive. Founder's Tree is one of the tallest Coastal Redwoods in existence. Walking the trail shows you the height, width and magnificence of the trees, as well as their eco-system. Enjoy the majesty and the quiet beautiful serenity. Arrive back in Davis late afternoon. (B)
