Spend a wonderful day in Grass Valley stepping back in the time of Gold Rush wealth with a docent lead tour of Bourn Cottage and Mineyard. Empire Mine State Historic Park is the site of one of the oldest, largest, deepest, longest and richest gold mines in California. The Bourne Cottage, which dates from 1897, was built for William Bourn Jr., owner of the Empire Mine from 1879 to 1929. The Cottage and its formal gardens were designed by Willis Polk, a well-known San Francisco architect. The Bourn family only intended to use the 4,600 square foot Cottage for short stays during the summer because of its location on the grounds of the Empire Mine with the constant noise of the stamp mill 24 hours a day. Bourn's primary residence at the time was in San Francisco. Enjoy a Miner's Luncheon served outdoors at the Clubhouse and includes your choice of beef, chicken or vegetable Cornish Pastry, coleslaw, ice cream, cookies and a beverage. Depart from the Target parking lot in Davis at 8:00 am and return at approximately 5:00 pm.
