This exhibition features paintings by Claude Monet dating mainly from 1913 to 1926, the final phase of the artist's long career. During his late years, the well-traveled Monet stayed close to home, inspired by the variety of elements making up his own garden at Giverny, a village located about 45 miles from Paris. With its evolving scenery of flower beds, footpaths, willows and wisteria, the garden became a personal laboratory for the artist's concentrated study of natural phenomena. The exhibition will focus on the series that Monet invented, and just as important, reinvented. Spend the afternoon at the Legion of Honor, a museum representing a great legacy of philanthropy and civic pride and stands proudly over the city, the Golden Gate and the Pacific Ocean. Lunch is on your own at the Museum Café. Depart from the Target parking lot in Davis at 8:30 am and return at approximately 5:00 pm.
