### Day 1: Flight from Sacramento to Honolulu

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Honolulu. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your ship, the Pride of America. Board the ship, find your cabin and get ready to relax and enjoy the beauty and laid-back aloha spirit of the Hawaiian Islands. Your ship sails at **7:00PM**

### Day 2: Kahului, Maui

On the northern coast of Maui's central valley, Kahului is a fairly large town, with shopping centers, a commercial harbor and cruise-ship dock, and Maui's main airport. A surplus of natural splendor and the genuine hospitality of its people have helped to make Maui Hawaii's second most popular island. The beaches have salt-and-pepper sand. The ship docks at **8:00AM** and you overnight on the ship!

### Day 3: Kahului, Maui

You have all day to discover Maui with snorkeling tours, whale watching and outrigger canoe experiences to name a few. No one can deny that Maui's beaches are some of the best in the world, but there's more to Maui than its coastline. Venturing inland leads to some truly breathtaking scenery that makes this island even more spectacular, and an exhilarating place to explore. ### Day 4: Hilo, Hawaii

Hilo, the largest city on the island of Hawaii and the second largest in the state, is a must-see, daylong visit for garden enthusiasts and probably a half-day trip for everyone else. Hilo is also a perfect base for visiting what residents simply refer to as The Volcano. Only 30 miles south of Hilo along Highway 11, Hawaii Volcanoes National Park is the home of the active Kilauea Volcano. Keep in mind that Hilo gets 280 days of rain a year (129 inches annually), but the rains don't last long. Moreover, while Hilo definitely has a large amount of rain, much of it is at night. Even when it does precipitate, they are usually just passing showers, and the abundant tropical rainfall is what makes the Hilo side of the Big Island so lush and green. The entire city of Hilo is like one giant greenhouse with spectacular tropical flowers at every turn. Visit the town's well-preserved historic buildings, which date back to the turn of the century and showcase Hawaii's unique architecture. Your ship docks at **8:00AM** and sails at **6:00PM**.

### Day 5: Kailua-Kona, Hawaii

Kona offers the quintessential Hawaii experience. Sunny, warm weather and crystal blue waters entice visitors to partake in a variety of surfside fun. Snorkel amongst a kaleidoscope of tropical marine life. Take a surfing lesson, a kayaking trip or head out to deeper waters for some deep-sea fishing. This famous area of the Big Island is on the western side along the coast North Kona and South Kona. Kailua-Kona is the name of the main town along the coast, with Kona added to distinguish it from other Kailuas. This tourist-oriented seaside village is at the base of 8,271 foot Mt Kaulalai. The main drag is Alii Dr, over a mile of oceanfront shops and restaurants. The newer Waterfront Row complex is at the southern end of the tourist strip. It is a shopping and dining complex. There is a seawall along the waterfront that is popular with fishermen and locals who weave hats and mats for tourists. There is the Kailua Pier where marlin are weighed in tournaments. Most big game fish are landed at Honokohau Harbor. Your ship docks at **7:00AM** and sails at **5:30PM**.



### Day 6: Nawiliwili, Kauai

Named after the Wiliwili trees, which once lined its picturesque harbor, this lovely port of Koa'u is your gateway to what many believe to be Hawaii's most beautiful island. On "The Garden Island," nature is truly the star, from the dramatic mountains of Kokee to the cool rainforests of Haena. And the tradition of the luau adds lively entertainment unique to Hawaii. Your ship docks at **8:00AM** and you overnight on the ship!

### 7: Nawiliwili, Kauai

As islands go, Kauai is not especially large. But the ramparts of its northwest coastline are so huge and so magnificent that even seasoned visitors continue to be in awe of their scale and beauty. Rivaling any coastline in the world for grandeur, Kauai's Napali Coast is a rugged 17-mile stretch of isolated parklands formed by millions of years of wind and water erosion. The resulting landscape is made up of sheer 3,000-foot cliffs (napali means "the cliffs"), lush green valleys, free-flowing waterfalls and secret sea caves. Kauai Island is farther north and west than the other major Hawaiian Islands. It has dramatic craggy mountains, luxuriant valleys and many breezy beaches that have mostly managed to dodge excessive development. Yes, Kauai has many hotels, resort complexes and some of the state's best golf courses, but they're centralized in small pockets on the east, north and south sides of the island. The landscape has also been protected by height restrictions—keeping buildings from towering over the coconut trees—and the interior of the island remains predominantly rural. As a result, it's the natural scenery that elicits awe on Kauai. Your ship sails at **5:30PM**.

### 8: Honolulu, Oahu

Welcome back to Honolulu! Your ship arrives in port at **7:00AM**. Disembark the Pride of America and transfer back to the airport for your flight back to Sacramento. We hope you had a wonderful time in beautiful Hawaii!

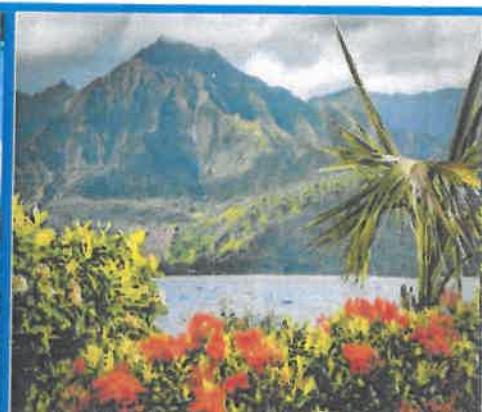
